



One lake. Two planes. Every capability an event consumer.

The system that observes your estate is the system that acts on it. Everything else in this design follows from that one decision.

THE EDGE

Observes and enforces in one process

Deterministic, inline, and fast enough to act before the thing it saw has finished happening. The sensor and the enforcement point are not two products joined by a ticket.

THE BRAIN

Learns, and compiles what it learns

A finding becomes a rule the edge enforces — validated against retained events, staged across the fleet, withdrawable on a measured clock.

THE LOOP

Closed, and it is the whole thesis

Most estates learn and enforce in different systems on different schedules. The gap between them is where the response time goes.

Everything is an event

one store • one clock • one identity per subject

OBSERVATIONS

process, network, identity, cloud control plane, change records, entitlements

JUDGEMENTS

detections, behavioural findings, and the analyst's own scoped, expiring verdicts

ACTIONS

what was done, by whom or by what, under which authority, and whether it was undone

Because all three are events on one clock, "what did we know at 11:02 and what did we do by 11:07" is a single query rather than a reconciliation across three products whose dates disagree.

WHAT THIS REPLACES

SIEM and UEBA joined by an integration that moves alerts rather than evidence.

An EDR that observes and a firewall that enforces, agreeing on nothing.

A SOAR whose playbooks describe an estate as it was when they were written.

Six meters, six renewal dates, and a capability you cannot switch on mid-incident.

WHAT WE WILL NOT CLAIM

Consolidation removes seams and creates a shared fate that six products did not have. One platform is one thing to compromise, and no amount of tenant isolation makes that untrue — it only bounds it.

We also do not see below the agent. Firmware and controller-resident implants are outside what this platform observes.

ONE METER

Events accepted. Every capability included.

Nothing to switch on at 02:00 that needs a procurement conversation first. The sizing calculator is public and needs no account.

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
